

Representation mandate in the context of a Class Action

ARTICLE 1 – PURPOSE

This mandate ("**Mandate**") empowers Stichting Onderzoek Marktinformatie (an association incorporated under Dutch law located at Stationsplein 45, Unit A4.004, 3013 AK Rotterdam, the Netherlands) ("**SOMI**"), a qualified entity and plaintiff in the action, to represent any person who is a member of the class action (the "**Class Member**") described at the link below <https://facebookclaim.fr/>, for the purposes of compensation, within the meaning of Article 849-17 of the French Code of Civil Procedure.

In accordance with Article 849-13 of the French Code of Civil Procedure, Membership of the Class Action does not imply or imply membership of SOMI.

ARTICLE 2 – EXCLUSIVE NATURE AND SCOPE OF THE MANDATE

The Class Member, if applicable also acting in the name and on behalf of any minor he or she legally represents, grants SOMI, on an exclusive basis, to the exclusion of any other representative, the power to represent him or her for all claims and claims falling within the scope of the Class Action.

In accordance with Article 849-13, 6° of the Code of Civil Procedure, membership of the Class Action entails a waiver of the right to act individually against the person declared liable for compensation for the damage already compensated in the context of the said action. This waiver is strictly limited to the damage falling within the scope of the Class Action and does not affect the right to act individually for any other separate damage.

The Mandate is conferred with the possibility of substitution, under the conditions provided for by law.

The Mandate constitutes the power given to SOMI to perform, in the name and on behalf of the Class Member, all procedural acts and due diligence in order to obtain compensation for the damage suffered by him and falling within the scope of the Class Action, in particular for the exercise of legal remedies.

SOMI advances all costs and expenses related to the procedure, under the conditions provided for by law.

ARTICLE 3 – DECLARATION D'ELIGIBILITE

The Class Member declares, under his or her sole responsibility, that he or she meets the eligibility and membership criteria for the group as defined by the court decision ruling on liability and accessible at the following address: <https://facebookclaim.fr/>

It is expressly stated that SOMI does not carry out any prior individual verification of the eligibility of the Group Member upon joining the group.

The admissibility of membership, inclusion in the group of beneficiaries and any right to compensation are exclusively at the discretion of the competent court.

It is recalled that, in accordance with Article 849-16 of the Code of Civil Procedure, persons who have not adhered within the time limit set by the judge are no longer entitled to claim their compensation in the context of the Class Action.

ARTICLE 4 – ABSENCE OF WARRANTY

Membership of the Class Action and the signing of this Mandate do not constitute any guarantee as to the individual admissibility of the Class Member, its effective inclusion in the group of beneficiaries, or as to the existence, amount or terms of any compensation.

The recognition of a right to compensation is a matter for the sovereign discretion of the judge.

ARTICLE 5 – DURATION AND REVOCATION

The Mandate takes effect from the date of its acceptance by the Group Member and remains valid until the final outcome of the Class Action.

In accordance with Article 849-17 of the French Code of Civil Procedure, the Class Member may revoke the Mandate at any time, by any means allowing it to be acknowledged. The revocation of the Mandate entails the renunciation of membership in the Class Action.

ARTICLE 6 – PERSONAL DATA

The processing of personal data in the context of the Mandate is governed by SOMI's Privacy Policy, which can be accessed on SOMI's website at the following address: <https://somi.nl/en/privacy-statement>.

ARTICLE 7 – APPLICABLE LAW AND COMPETENT JURISDICTION

This Mandate is governed by French law. Any dispute relating to the interpretation, execution or validity of the Mandate will be subject to French law and falls under the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent French courts.
